Message from the University Librarian 🖓

I am very delighted to join the Lingnan University as the Chief Information Officer and University Librarian at this opportune moment when the University is growing to become a premier liberal arts university in Asia. In my previous role as the Senior Sub-Librarian at the Chinese University of Hong Kong, I used to support research, teaching and learning of the University community with the application of technology, and the development of various online platforms and IT facilities. Inspired by the University's desire to transform, I will leverage the best of IT and Library in my dual role to advance the mission of the University.

I still need time to get together with my team of dedicated library staff to devise a strategic plan to guide us to continually improve our services. One of the projects on the pipeline is library renovation to make more innovative use of the space to provide 24-hour access, to setup different studying and learning space to suit the style of different user groups, and to act as an innovation hub of the University. Another major project is the development of a new scholarly portal to showcase the research excellence of Lingnan. More updates on these plans will be provided in the coming months.

Behind the scene, the library staff members are working closely to prepare for the new academic term. A new series of

orientation and library workshops are underway. Exhibitions and book talks will also be organized. I would like to take this opportunity to express my deepest gratitude to all students and staff who participated in two library surveys recently, namely, Library User Satisfaction Survey and Library Survey of Research Postgraduate Students. I am very pleased to know that we obtained a record high overall satisfaction score of 4.07 in a 5-point scale since the survey has been conducted in 1997. It is also the first time the Library conducted the postgraduate survey to solicit the views of research postgraduates. All the comments expressed are valuable to guide the library development and we will definitely work on those areas.

Another encouraging news is that the Digital Commons @ Lingnan for showcasing scholarly publications has recorded over 1 million cumulative downloads since its launch in 2012, another milestone that is achieved within just 6 years. My congratulations to the team's effort and all users who find this platform helpful to their research.

The campus is quiet in the summer. I am looking forward to meeting with each one of you soon to hear your views on how the Library can serve you better.



2018 Library User Satisfaction Survey

Thank you all users for participating in the 2018 Library User Satisfaction Survey. We are very pleased to receive a record high overall satisfaction score of 4.07 in a 5-point scale since the survey has been conducted in 1997. It represented a 2.9% increase from the last year's score.



Amongst all the library services, "Circulation Services" scored the highest 4.28 out of the 5-point scale followed by "Reference Services" whose score was 4.18. "Circulation Services – Helpful" (4.32), "Circulation Service – Friendly" (4.32) and "Security" (4.31) were the top three of the individual items. "Journals & Magazines" (9.0%), "Individual Study Rooms" (8.6%), "E-Books (Chinese)" (8.4%) were the top three items with the greatest increase in score when compared with the scores in 2017. Our heartfelt thanks for your comments and feedbacks which are valuable for our continuous improvement.



Past Events & Exhibitions Lingnan Foundation Delegates, reunited with Szto Wai's Paintings



In 2008, Lingnan Foundation in the United States donated a collection of 46 watercolours and sketches created by Mr. Szto Wai and his students to the University. A decade later, Dr. Ding-Jo Hsia Currie, President of Lingnan Foundation and Ms. Rona Henry, Director of Grants – Lingnan Foundation plus 11 Fellows of Lingnan W. T. Chan Fellowship Program (陳氏學者獎學金) visited Lingnan Archives on 07 Jun 2018, to reunite with this collection.

These paintings, featuring the original campus of Lingnan University in Guangzhou during 1937-1944, have undergone a long journey with different benefactors, until they were finally home to the Lingnan

University through Lingnan Foundation. With unique aesthetic and historical value of these paintings, Lingnan Foundation keeps adopting selective paintings in their publicity materials, representing the continuance of the Lingnan spirit.
